Greetings from Indian School Jalan!

APAAR ID

As per the latest CBSE guidelines, our school will be implementing the **APAAR ID (Automated Permanent Academic Account Registry ID)** for all students.

APAAR ID is a lifelong unique 12-digit identifier, that will help in maintaining a comprehensive academic record of each student, accessible across schools and higher education institutions. Students can store and access their exam results, achievements, participation in activities such as Olympiads, sports, etc.

For the generation of the APAAR ID, it is mandatory for all Indian students to have an Aadhaar Card. Therefore, parents are requested to kindly ensure that their ward possesses a valid Aadhaar Card at the earliest, if not already done.

We request your cooperation in completing the necessary requirements for APAAR ID creation.

It is mandatory for all Indian students of Class IX - XI students to have an Aadhaar Card at the time of registering for the Board Examinations. You are, therefore, kindly requested to obtain an Aadhaar Card at the earliest, as the registration process will commence soon.

Please note that the school will not be responsible for any student's registration left unprocessed by CBSE due to the non-availability of an Aadhaar Card.

Two Board Examination Policy

As per the recommendations of the New Education Policy (NEP), CBSE has decided to implement the policy of conducting **two Board Examinations** with effect from the academic session **2025-26**.

This policy will enable students to appear for two examinations in a given school year –

- One main examination (February – March)
- One improvement examination, if desired (May tentatively)

This initiative aims to reduce academic stress and provide students with a fair chance to enhance their performance.

Attendance

As per the CBSE Examination By-Laws, it is mandatory to fulfil 75% attendance in order to be eligible to appear for the Board Examination.

Students are, therefore, advised to maintain regular attendance and ensure compliance with this requirement to avoid any inconvenience at the time of Board Examination.
